The Conference is organized by the Institute of Biology, Pomeranian University in Słupsk, Słupsk, Poland; National Academy of Agrarian Sciences of Ukraine; Institute of Climate-Smart Agriculture of the National Academy of Agrarian Sciences of Ukraine (NAAS), Odessa, Ukraine; National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine, Kyiv, Ukraine; T. H. Shevchenko National University "Chernihiv Collegium", Chernihiv, Ukraine, and Collegium Medicum of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, Poland.

We invite scientific and scientific-educational personnel from scientific institutions and universities in the biological, agricultural, pharmaceutical, medical and veterinary fields, as well as doctoral candidates, postgraduates, students and employees of companies and related public organizations.

The proceedings of the conference will be published as an electronic Book of Abstracts.

The conference will be held in a combined format (offline and online via Zoom Meetings).

The official conference languages are Polish, Ukrainian and English.

The conference will be held within sections:

- 1. Medicine and eco-medicine;
- 2. Innovative technologies for plant health;
- 3. Animal health, welfare and climate-oriented animal farming;
- 4. Modern approaches to ensuring and assuring food safety and quality;
- 5. Digital transformation in crop and livestock production: introduction of new technologies using artificial intelligence.

Requirements for attending the conference:

To participate in this conference, it is necessary to first contact the organizing committee by e-mail at primaveraryna@gmail.com and biology.apsl@gmail.com and send the electronic version of the Abstract **before 15**th **May 2024.**

Abstracts for publication will only be accepted in the electronic form in one of the conference languages. You will receive an e-mail message informing you if your Abstract has been accepted for publication. Materials that do not meet the requirements, require substantial editing, or are received after the deadline may be rejected and authors will be notified.

Participation in the conference is free of charge.

Abstract submission

The abstract should be prepared using Microsoft Word compatible software (*.doc or *.docx). The total length of the abstract (A4 format), including tables, figures and references, can be 1-5 pages. All margins must be 2 cm, font Times New Roman, size 12, single-spaced, paragraph indents 1.25 cm, preand post-paragraph spacing 0 pt (none), fully justified, no hyphenation, portrait orientation, no page numbering.

The abstract heading includes: first line – abstract title (bold); second line – authors' first and last names separated by commas (bold italics); third line – full title of organization, city, country; fourth line – e-mails of all authors (italics); fifth line (bold italics)– keywords (up to 5 words). The body of the abstract follows one blank line. Abstracts should contain the following parts: introduction, materials and methods, results and their discussion, conclusions. The body of the abstract should be followed by a list of references (no more than 10 sources in alphabetical order). References are listed in the text with the list number of the source in square brackets. References are presented in the original language, formatted according to APA style (https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammarguidelines/references/examples#textual-works).

Chemical structures should be in IsisDraw format, mathematical formulations should be in the built-in editor, Microsoft Equation; pictures and figures should be in *.jpg or *.tiff format. Latin names of biological objects should be given in italics. No abbreviations of words or terms should be used in the title of the publication; abbreviations in the text may be defined at the first mention. Publications should use the SI system of units. A file should contain only one abstract. The file name should be the name of the first author (e.g. Hetmanski et al.doc). If more than one abstract is submitted by one author, the files should be numbered in the Arabic numerals (e.g. Hetmanski et al1.doc).

Abstracts formatted according to the requirements should be sent by e-mail to **primaveraryna@gmail.com and biologia.up.slupsk@gmail.com before 15**th **May 2024.** Proceedings (electronic version) and certificates will be sent to each author within one week after 5th June 2024.
